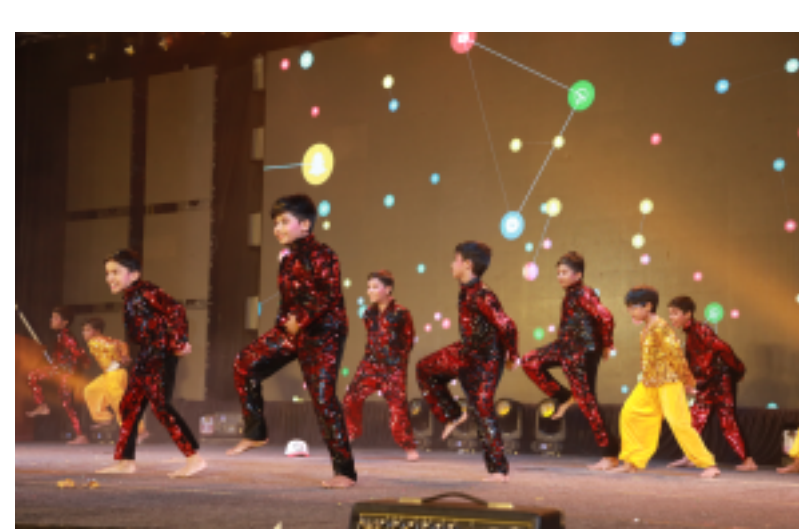

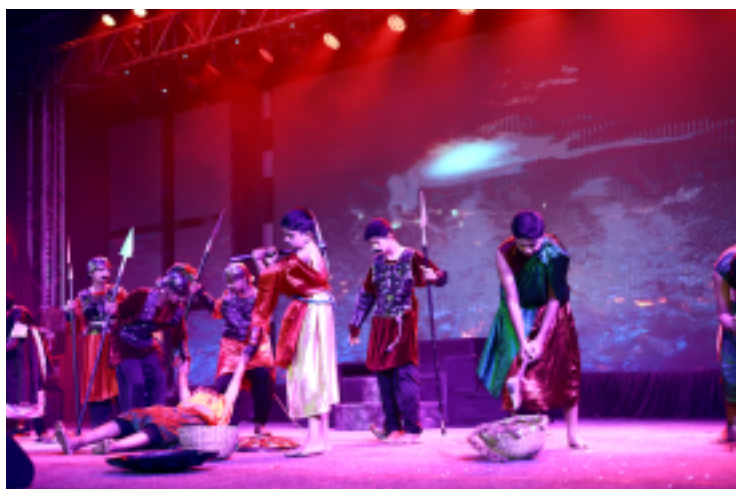

THREE PLAYS IN TWO DAYS

The Heart of Wayanad (English)

Ek Phool Ki Chaah (Hindi)

Biriyani (Malayalam)



Art is a reflection of life. As the sun colours flowers, so does art colour life, shedding light on the humanity that makes us whole. The 64th Annual Day Celebration at Loyola School was the embodiment of this idea, transcending all barriers with poignant segments that deeply connected the audience to their common humanity, all the while painting a picture of life on this planet that nurtures us. From exploring the five elements—earth, water, fire, air, and space—to delivering much-needed commentary on the place humanity deserves in this rat-race that dominates today's world, the evening's performances drew the audience to a world created onstage, and into the storylines of the plays presented this year.

The English play, *The Heart of Wayanad*, gave a voice to the stories of the countless victims of the 2024 landslides as it explored the sorrow of a mother who lost her family to the tragedy. Its narrative remains a reminder of the pain caused by these disasters, and the very real losses faced by their victims. Through choreography that embodied foreshadowing and devastation, the play took its audience through darkness, fear, and hopelessness, but, in the end, lifted their spirits with a glimpse of healing and resilience.

Under the direction of Fr Sheise Thomas, SJ, the script, written and enacted by the students of Class XI, found life in this performance, made possible by the dedicated support of Ms Baijayantee Bhattacharya and Ms Anjana Nair, and augmented by the dance sequences choreographed by Ms Sweety Prathewsh and her student, Ms Ilaa Irene.

Biriyani, the Malayalam play, was loosely based on the short story of the same name written by Santhosh Aechikkanam. It portrayed the stark contrast between the hapless ones smarting under privation and the filthy rich engrossed in extravagance and exploitation. The plot centres on a worker tasked with disposing of leftover biriyani from a lavish wedding—an act that triggers heartbreaking memories of his daughter, who lost her life to starvation. Heartfelt and emotional, the play succeeded in making the spectators think twice before letting food go to waste. The commitment of the cast, under the flawless guidance of Mr Sooraj S.R. and Ms Thulasi Kumari, gave life to this tale and moved the audience to tears.

The Hindi play, *Ek Phool Ki Chaah*, inspired by Siyaramsharan Gupta's poem, directed the spotlight to the remains of the caste system. While the leaders of the freedom fighters and the reformers successfully erased this blight from our constitution, our society still suffers under the burden of the attitudes that brought it forth.

The play skilfully brought out how the society still looks at individuals, not as human beings, but as members of a multitude of divisions, the most visible

of which is caste. The play centred on a father determined to fulfil his daughter's dying wish to receive a flower from the feet of the Goddess of a temple. Denied entry and brutalized for his low caste, the desperate man was imprisoned, left to rot as the world moved on without him. When, at last, he was freed, his daughter was no more, leaving him broken. This play instilled in the audience the thought that just as every petal of a flower is a petal, so is every individual in human society a human. Beautifully executed, the entire team presented this marvellous creation thanks to the excellent stewardship of Ms Anita Kumari and Dr Aswathy Raj.

On the whole, each production tackled a different aspect of human life and provided an enriching experience for both its participants and the audience. The messages of these three plays are sure to resonate in our hearts, and the cumulative impact of the theatre segment of the School Day programme will linger for a long while.

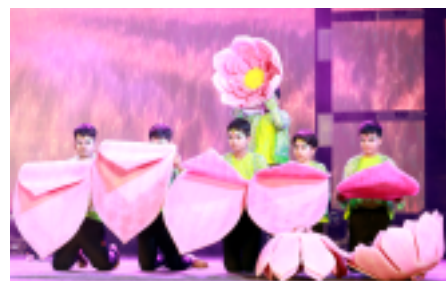

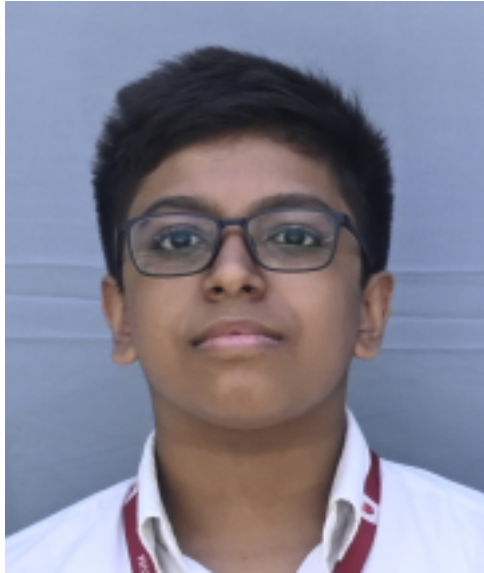

As a teacher it was a deeply personal and humbling journey, one that I believe will stay with our students long after the memory of textbooks and exams fades. With the aim of fostering empathy and deeper understanding of human suffering, Loyola School under the leadership of Principal and Director Fr Salvin Augustine SJ, Principal Sr Jiji Thomas, Vice Principal Ms Roshini Joseph, Registrar Mr Joy M Varghese, PTA President Dr Anju Deepak, PTA executive member Mr Rakesh, a group of 52 students, teachers, parents and members of the non-teaching staff visited six selected institutions as a part of their annual charity drive called *Loaf of Love*.

On 21 December 2024, we started our journey with a solemn prayer session led by Rector and Manager Rev. Fr Sunny Kunnapallil SJ. We were all set with the carol band, Christmas gifts etc. and boarded the bus to our first

destination, Lourdes Matha Cancer Care Home. While direct interaction with the patients was limited in order to prevent infection, we spent time at the courtyard singing carols and observing the resilience of the patients who applauded from the floor verandas. As a token of support, our Principals handed over our contribution also. Fr Moban Chooravady, the Director of the Care Home, gave us a detailed picture of the sufferings of the patients and the critical role played by the Nuns and a Doctor there.

Our next destination was Jayamatha Boys Home at Nalanchira run by Franciscan Missionaries. We were warmly welcomed by Br Dominic, the Director, and another official. Here we were able to engage more directly with the boys. Loyolites sang carols and handed over the Christmas gifts by the PTA. Jayamatha had their own band who surprised us with their talents. Also, Fr Salvin distributed the prizes to the winners of a cricket tournament held there. We were able to create a festive atmosphere there; after all Christmas is round the corner!

Aswas Bhavan, Vilappilsala home for destitute and lunatic patients, told us a different story. The home welcomed us with its lush greenery and rare plants taken care of by the inmates. Maybe this creates a comfortable supportive atmosphere as many of the members were recovering from drug addiction and have a criminal background. This home is maintained well under the leadership of Mr Sasidharan, a retired village officer. Despite his health problems, he gave a strong message.

After lunch, we travelled to Vettukad and reached Divya Santhi Ashramam by 2.40 p m. It was established in 1995 and is a

home that takes care of the physical, mental and psychological health of the destitute and the mentally challenged. There also we handed over our gifts and sang carols.

We got an opportunity to visit the famous Mother of God Church at Vettukad as well as spend a little time at the beach before moving to our fifth destination, Lenny Peter's Girls' Home, Vettuthura, run by dedicated Sisters. Their mission is to provide a supporting environment for girls who have faced unsafe conditions at home. We understood it as a place where they can heal, grow and build a brighter future. The air buzzed with excitement as we witnessed the radiant smile of Geetha as she cut her birthday cake, along with Sr Jiji Thomas. The highlight at Lenny Peter's was the presentation of a new LED TV by the PTA.

Our final destination was Assissi Nikethan Old Age Home, Gandhipuram. We reached there around 6 p m. This home for the elderly had a deep impact on our team. Loneliness seemed to have etched itself on their faces as these mothers, weathered by time and life, were all settled to a quiet existence. Yet, all of them enjoyed the mood of Christmas as we sang the carols. A gentle touch, a listening ear, a shared smile brought out their unexpected radiance. And with that, we came to the end of the days' mission as directed by God himself.

Loaf of Love truly instilled in us a deeper sense of gratitude for our own blessings and inspired the students, teachers, parents and non-teaching staff at Loyola School to continue the efforts in making a positive impact on the lives of the less fortunate.
